Safe Harbor is a non-profit ministry that provides a Christ-centered community for rebuilding, renewing and recovery. Our programs focus on meeting people where they identify their needs, and providing evidence-based, faith-inspired resources for success. This is done through the two major arms of our ministry, New Day and Thrive.

NEW DAY: New Day is a collection of classes, groups and programs for women and children.

NOW – New Opportunities for Women

NOW is focused on reducing barriers and providing hope for quality living for women and children who are experiencing homelessness and for women in transitional living situations.

MINnows – Mothers and Infants Nurturing Program

The Minnows program is a drop-in type nursery school for infants and toddlers between the ages of birth to four years. The program is free of charge to mothers who are participating in any of Safe Harbor's programs, or those referred to Safe Harbor by partnering agencies.

Greenleaf Transitional Living Program

Greenleaf provides low-cost, safe, clean, and fully furnished apartments for women and families looking for structure and assistance with preparing for successful independent living. This program is for individual women or women with three or fewer children who are mentally and physically able to meet program goals.

The Bridge

The Bridge program reaches into high-risk populations to prevent sex trafficking and to help victims find hope and healing. By walking across that bridge with them, they are more hopeful and ready to plug into the other New Day Program assistance.

THRIVE RECOVERY: Many families and individuals in our community find themselves barely surviving due to substance use disorders. Not only do we believe that recovery is possible, we believe that persons in recovery can THRIVE!

Whole Woman Residential Program

Safe Harbor's capstone program is a year-long, residential program for women who are seeking to go deeper than sobriety, women who want real freedom and life change.

Thrive Recovery Community (Co-ed)

Thrive is an active community of families and individuals who are grateful for another day of life and hopeful for a healthy and successful future. Thrive Offers: Sober Living Activities, Classes, Groups, Artistic Expression Opportunities and immediate recovery resources assistance

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All play is governed by the 2018 USGA Rules of Golf. The format is Captain's Choice on each hole.
2. Mulligans can be used for any drive, approach shot or putt, except to win a prize such as closest to the pin.
3. Balls may be moved one club length but no closer to the hole. The ball must stay in same condition as the original. For instance, you cannot move the ball from the rough to the fairway or from a sand trap to the rough.
4. Men will play from white tees and ladies from red tees. 65 and over from senior tees.
5. Appropriate golf attire required. No tank tops, t-shirts, cut-offs, sweat pants, athletic shorts, swim trunks, tennis shorts, denim jeans or denim shorts or cargo pants.
